- Those in our Community who are sick and worried that God will bless them
- For the NHS and all people working in the medical and carer sectors that God will protect and support them.
- For all 'Key Workers' at this time that God will support them with there work
- Our local Doctors surgeries that people will respect the Doctors, nurses and receptionists
- Our local shops that people will not be greedy and only buy what they need
- Those in our villages who are worried about their jobs and how they will cope if they can't work that God will provide
- For our local children as they try to learn at home and miss their friends
 that God will guide their parents and give them patience
- For families self-isolating because one member is poorly that God will be with them
- For those who have life-threatening illnesses and feel especially vulnerable -that God will take away their fear
- We pray for ourselves that we can be used by our Heavenly Father to help others and to spread His love and compassion
- We pray for understanding of those who seem to be "breaking the rules" because they can't cope mentally with the situation
- For the homeless and the Foodbank
- We pray for those who will die this week
- We pray for our Government and those in positions of authority, that they will seek the common good
- We pray for the scientists who are trying to find a vaccine for this virus

- We pray for other countries, particularly poorer places where they do not have adequate medical supplies – remembering Kenyan and our sponsored children, Eunice and Eric
